Entry and payment

Last day of entry is the 31st of May 2011. Late entries will be accepted to the extent that there is enough capacity and until 60 minutes before start. Late entries are possible at a double entry fee and **late entries for separate** classes will be allowed to a double starting fee. All classes are open for purebred Arabian horses registered in a WAHO approved studbook. To receive a SC-title Swedish citizenship is required.

Entry is to be made either electronically or manual. "Electronic entry forms" or "manual entry forms" are to be filled in or printed out at www.sahf.se or www.sasc.se
A photocopy of the registration-document should be sent together with the entry form.

Starting fees are to be paid at Bökeberg.

Any registered equipage will be counted as starting and therefore charged with full starting fees. Repayment of starting fees will only be compensated if a veterinary- or doctor's certificate is brought. Equipage that has started in a class will not have the right to reclaim the starting fee.

Announcement for starting shall be done in the show office. The show office has the following opening hours:

Restrooms and showers are available at Bökeberg. Only a limited number of reservations can be made so be sure to book as soon as possible.

All stabling of horses is done at Bökeberg in permanent boxes. A deposit fee of 200 SEK shall be paid at the show office when arriving and will be returned when boxes are emptied. Boxes that aren't emptied will be charged with a fee of 500 SEK!

The organizer is not responsible for the horses stabled at the event. The booking of stable box is binding and the fee should be paid along with the entry fee.

Ethics and rules

The event will be governed by ECAHO's Green Book which can be downloaded at www.ecaho.org A copy of Green Book will also be available at the show office and abstracts in Swedish and English can be found on www.sasc.se or www.sahf.se Western classes will be governed by AQHA's book of rules and regulations and can be found at www.aqha.com A summary containing the useful information for this competition can be found at www.sahf.se and www.sasc.se

*Number tags must be worn at all times when handling, riding or longeing the horse.

*Horses must be at the age of four to be ridden at show ground.

* Mares in foal of five months or with foals younger than 5 months by their side are not allowed to enter the event.

* All horses must have a valid passport and vaccination to be able to participate. If valid vaccinations aren't registered in the passport a separate folder for vaccinations has to be brought.

* Bad treatment of horses which causes illness or limping while riding or handling the horse leads to suspension. Manual supervision will be performed during the entire event.

Dressage on Friday is ridden outdoor on dirt and the classes on Sunday are ridden indoor. Even show jumping and western are ridden both indoor and outdoor and western classes that require special bas is conducted indoors. The show class will be conducted outdoors but in case of bad weather it will be conducted indoor. Cross country will be conducted both indoors and outdoors in a combination. Warm up is conducted outdoors and in a special section indoor. More detailed information concerning each class will be posted in "notice to riders". A preliminary schedule for classes can be found on www.sahf.se and www.sasc.se

Please observe that helmet, long sleeved shirt and security vest is compulsory in the speed and cross country classes. Whip and spurs are not allowed in the speed class. Security vest is compulsory for youngsters under 18 when performing show jumping. We recommend youngsters under the age of 18 to wear a helmet during the show class as well and to show a stallion the handler must be at least 15 years old.

Number tags are compulsory in all classes and are to be worn on either rider or horse. Number tags can be provided by the show office.

Veterinarian inspection is mandatory for all horses participating in show jumping classes 41 & 43, pole bending, cross country and speed. This inspection will take place on **Saturday morning at 07:00- 09:00 am**. The veterinarian fee of 175 SEK is paid once, at the same time as starting fees.

Classes and cups

There are four difficulty levels for the classic cups and three for the western cups. Points from at least four classes (show class + three riding classes) will be counted for the total point in the separate cups, and is mandatory to be able to participate in a cup. Out of the three riding classes at least one has to be **dressage or show jumping** in classic or **reining or trail** in western.

Please observe that participation in the obligatory classes will determine which cup a equirage will compete in. Please be careful to observe which the mandatory classes are when deciding for which cup level to participate in.

Which cup one would like to participate in has got to be announced in the entry form.

"Show class is obligatory for all cups" class 51-53 according to the horse's sex.

Western:	Bronze cup	includes classes: 51-53, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 03
	Silver cup	includes classes: 51-53, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 03
	Gold cup	includes classes: 51-53, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 03
	High point rider	will be chosen from the collected point from classes during Saturday and Sunday. Please be certain to decide which cup to participate in.

National championships/Scandinavian championships

Western: SC/NC in western are decided from classes on Sunday.

Classic: SC/NC in dressage and show jumping from the classes on Sunday.

Dressage:	classes 44 & 45
Show Jumping:	classes 41 & 43

Each class requires a minimum of five entries and to be able to announce a Scandinavian champion at least three countries has to participate. National and Scandinavian champions will be selected out of the same classes. To be able to participate in classes that take place on Sunday qualifications are necessary. Riders must have participated in B-level classes or higher to be qualified. Qualifications can be made during classes on Saturday for western riders.
